

LEARN ADDICTION E-learning Platform for Addiction Treatment Professionals

International Cooperation Project | Ongoing



Dianova Portugal is one of the partners of the E-learning Platform for Addiction Treatment Professionals Project, funded under the Erasmus+ programme with 5 other entities: UNAD – Red de Atención a las Adicciones (Spain), Sananim (Czech Republic), RHRN – Harm Harm Reduction Network (Romania), Le Pelican and FEDITO BXL, Fédération bruxelloise des Institutions pour Toxicomanes (Belgium), and Institut Utrip (Slovenia).

The project aims to provide professionals working to support people with addiction skills in:

- > prevention, intervention and treatment of substance-free addictions (online gambling, social networks, etc.).
- > gender perspective in the prevention, intervention and treatment of addictions.
- > European standards of quality in addiction prevention.

The first transnational kick-off meeting of the project took place from 5 to 7 November 2019 in Madrid.

Kick off the European project 'Learn Addiction' led by UNAD

A group of six entities will develop an online dependency learning platform

On 5, 6 and 7 November, UNAD, the Addiction Assistance Network, organized in Madrid the first meeting of the 'Learn Addiction' project, attended by specialists in addictions from six European countries.

The initiative, which will run over two years until the end of October 2021, aims to meet the training needs of technical professionals in the European addiction sector. Thus, a consortium composed of entities specializing in the treatment of addictions in Spain, Portugal, Slovenia, the Czech Republic, Belgium and Romania will launch the first open and multilingual e-Learning platform on different addictions issues.

In this context, topics such as the prevention of substance-free dependence, the inclusion of a gender perspective or intervention with young people and adolescents will be addressed.

At this first meeting of the project, in addition to establishing guidelines for the creation of the e-Learning platform, the participating entities had the opportunity to learn more about the work of UNAD, as well as its technical and management team.
